<u>V+J</u> <u>February 18, 2024</u> <u>Salesian Reflection</u> <u>First Sunday of Lent</u>

In today's Gospel we experience Jesus being tempted in the desert. St. Francis de Sales notes:

Jesus did not seek temptation. The Holy Spirit led Him into the desert to be tempted. If we

encounter temptation in that place where the Spirit of God leads us, we must be firmly confident that God will strengthen us against these temptations no matter how strong they may be. Yet, no matter how holy and generous we may think ourselves to be, we must never trust in our own strength or courage, and go out and seek temptation, thinking we can confound it. Nonetheless, we must prepare ourselves to rise above temptation. Like Jesus, we must arm ourselves with the truth of God. This truth is nothing other than faith, which shields us from temptations. When we say, "I believe" in God the Almighty, we place our trust in God's power, not in our own strength.

As soon as you are conscious of being tempted, follow the example of children when they see a wolf or bear out in the country. They immediately run to the arms of their parents or call to them for help and protection. *If the temptation continues, embrace the Holy Cross and look at our Lord. Then, turn your thoughts to some good constructive activity.* Our temptations are like a chained dog. If we do not approach them they will do us no harm, even if they try to frighten us by barking at us.

Sometimes when we are faced with a temptation, in the beginning we feel wounded by some troubled emotion. Alas, we might think that it is almost impossible to serve God in holiness. Don't trouble yourself with such an idle fear. Armed with the truth of God's Word, God will strengthen us and give us the grace to persevere to do what is required for God's glory and our own welfare and happiness.

<u>V+J</u> <u>18 Febrero de 2024</u> <u>Salesianos Dominicales</u> <u>Primer Domingo de la Cuaresma</u>

En el Evangelio de hoy experimentamos el momento en que Jesús fue tentado en el desierto. San Francisco de Sales hace la siguiente observación al respecto:

Jesús no fue en busca de la tentación. El Espíritu Santo lo llevó al desierto para que fuera tentado.

Si el Espíritu Santo nos guía hasta un lugar en donde encontramos una tentación, debemos confiar plenamente en que Dios nos dará la fuerza necesaria para resistir dicha tentación sin importar cuán fuerte parezca. Aún así, no importa cuán santos y generosos creamos que somos, jamás debemos confiarnos de nuestra propia fortaleza y coraje, y salir en busca de la tentación creyendo que podremos derrotarla. Debemos prepararnos para lograr sobreponernos a las tentaciones. Al igual que Jesús, debemos armarnos con la verdad de Dios. Esta verdad no es otra que la fe, la cual nos protege de la tentación. Cuando nosotros decimos **"Yo creo"** en Dios Todopoderoso, estamos depositando toda nuestra confianza en el poder de Dios, no en nuestra propia fuerza.

En el momento en que ustedes se percaten de que la tentación los está asechando, hagan lo mismo que hacen los niños cuando ven un lobo o un oso en el bosque: Ellos corren inmediatamente a los brazos de sus padres, o los llaman para que los ayuden y les brinden protección. Si la tentación persiste aférrense con fuerza a la Sagrada Cruz, vuélvanse a Nuestro Señor y enfoquen sus pensamientos en una actividad que sea productiva y constructiva. Nuestras tentaciones son como perros encadenados: si no nos acercamos a ellos no nos harán daño, aún cuando traten de asustarnos con sus ladridos. A veces sucede que cuando nos enfrentamos a una tentación, al principio nos sentimos como si hubiésemos sido heridos por una emoción que nos resulta preocupante. Hasta puede que lleguemos a pensar que nos resulta imposible servir a Dios en la santidad. No se deje amedrentar por miedos infundados. Ármense con la verdad de la Palabra de Dios; ÉL los fortalecerá y les dará la gracia para perseverar y cumplir con todo lo que la gloria de Dios, y el bienestar y la felicidad de todos nosotros, requiere.

many patients receiving urgent medical care, the need for blood doesn't stop for winter weather. That's why we need donors like you now and we'll share our





If you wish to remember a family member or friend, there is a *Memorial Tree in the foyer for which a leaf can be purchased.* Leaves can be inscribed



DO YOU WANT to FAST for LENT?

In the words of Pope Francis...

- Fast from hurting words and speak kind words.
- Fast from sadness and be filled with gratitude.
- Fast from anger and be filled with patience.
- Fast from pessimism and be filled with hope.
- * Fast from worries and *trust in God*.
- Fast from complaints and *contemplate simplicity*.
- * Fast from pressures and *be prayerful*.
- Fast from bitterness and fill your heart with joy.
- Fast from selfishness and be compassionate to others.
- * Fast from grudges and *be reconciled*.
- Fast from words so you can be silent and listen.

WHAT IS THE PASTORAL/PARISH COUNCIL?

The pastoral council is a planning council, not a coordinating council. It is where cooperative planning occurs. The consultation of the pastoral council is essential in the decision-making process of the parish, but the council is not the decision maker. The pastor is the head of the pastoral council. He may, but does not have to, appoint members to ensure balance and to see that all segments of the parish are represented (e.g., Saturday evening Mass group and Sunday morning Mass group).

Who should be a member of the pastoral council?

Council members must meet the following criteria:

- Be a Roman Catholic in good standing with the Church;
- Be a registered and supporting member of the parish;
- Be a participant in parish life and worship;
- Be committed to prayer, study, listening and dialogue;
- Be committed to giving the time needed for participation; and
- Be aware of and comply with Parish Conflict of Interest Policy.
- In addition, he or she should possess the following gifts necessary for pastoral leadership:
- A desire for spiritual growth in oneself and in the parish;
- Eagerness to participate in parish decisions about its direction;
- Willingness to listen, speak openly and honestly, and to work toward consensus;
- The ability to inspire others and to delegate; a commitment to cooperation, flexibility and openness toward people and ideas.
