As we continue our Lenten journey, the prophet Jeremiah turns our attention to the new covenant God desires to establish with his people. *“All, from least to greatest, will know the Lord. He will write the law on our hearts and forgive our evildoing and remember our sins no more.”*

In today’s Gospel, Jesus announces *that the “hour” has come*. When he is lifted up from the earth, he will draw all to himself. *Jesus has chosen to strip himself of his divinity and become human like us so that we would know the great love God has for us.*

Now he is preparing himself to be the grain of wheat that will fall to the ground and die in order to produce much fruit. This will be the hour of our salvation.

Because Jesus is obedient to his Father whom he loves dearly, he will suffer and die for the sins of the whole world. He will reconcile the whole human race with God. With his death and rising, Jesus will complete God’s new covenant. *Through the grace of Baptism, God’s law is now written on our hearts.* We become God’s children once again, able to call God **“Father.”**

When we go within our hearts to listen to God’s word, we must not be surprised that we encounter a challenge. Jesus will challenge us to follow him wherever he goes, to do the will of his Father, as he did. Like Jesus, we may feel troubled at times with what we have to face each day. Like Jesus, we will come to understand that our Father is with us in everything we do. We have nothing to fear. We heard Jesus tell us: *“My Father will honor whoever serves me.”* That is Jesus’ promise to us.

Let us be *faithful* to the new covenant Jesus has made with us. *Let us listen to our heart; it is there that God speaks to us.* Let us *strive* each day to do with love all that our God asks of us. *Let us ask Jesus, who has died and risen for us, to draw us closer to him and one another each day.*

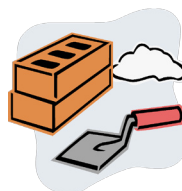

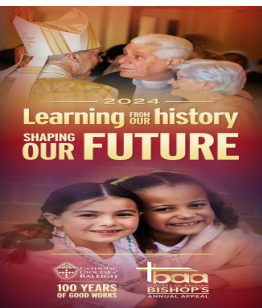

WHY DO WE VEIL THE CRUCIFIX?

The last two weeks in the season of Lent are called Passiontide which begins on the Fifth Sunday of Lent.

This is when the Church shifts her focus from Christ in the desert (the Gospel for the First Sunday of Lent) to Christ during His Passion. During this period of Passiontide, you may have noticed in your parish that the crucifix has been veiled with a purple cloth.

In the Roman Missal we find the instruction, *“In the Dioceses of the United States, the practice of covering crosses and images throughout the church from [the fifth] Sunday [of Lent] may be observed. Crosses remain covered until the end of the Celebration of the Lord’s Passion on Good Friday, but images remain covered until the beginning of the Easter Vigil.”*

The veils are hard to miss and they serve as a reminder to get ready! The veiled crucifix builds within us a longing for Easter Sunday. The veil seems out of place, and even counterintuitive. It can seem strange that the crucifix is covered up during Passiontide. Through this absence of images, our senses are heightened and we become more aware of what is missing. Similarly, the suppression of the Alleluia during Lent effectively demonstrates that we are in exile from our true Home, where the angels sing Alleluia without ceasing.

When images are unveiled before the Easter Vigil, we are reminded that we, in a sense, live in a veiled world.

It is through our own death that we are able to see our true home, and the veil is lifted.

Christ lifts the veil through His Resurrection.

NORMS FOR FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

Good Friday, March 29, 2024 is a day of fasting and abstinence. Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence. Fasting is to be observed by all 18 years of age and older, who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one’s needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Abstinence is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence, no meat is allowed. The faithful should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance. El viernes santo, 29 de marzo del 2024, es día de abstinencia y de ayuno. También deben abstenerse los viernes durante la Cuaresma. Todas las personas a partir de los 18 años de edad y los que no hayan cumplido los 59 años de edad, deben ayunar. Se permite comer una vez durante el día de ayuno, aunque también pueden comer dos veces para mantener la energía, según la necesidad de cada individuo. Sin embargo, estas dos comidas no deben igualar a la cantidad de una comida completa. La abstinencia se debe cumplir desde los 14 años de edad en adelante. En los días de abstinencia, no se debe comer carne. El ayuno, la limosna y la oración, son las tres disciplinas tradicionales durante la Cuaresma. Los feligreses deben realizar estas prácticas con seriedad en espíritu de penitencia.

What is FASTING?
The **limitation** of food and drink – typically to one main meal and two smaller meals, with no solid foods in between
But remember to drink enough fluids!

When do we fast?
Ash Wednesday & Good Friday*

*Paschal Fast: Good Friday and Holy Saturday are days of prayer and quiet reflection. We honour the suffering and death of Jesus and prepare to share in the joy of his resurrection at Easter.

What is ABSTINENCE?
Avoiding certain kinds of food or drink, typically meat or other desirable foods

When do we abstain?
Catholics are obliged to abstain from **meat every Friday** throughout the year (except solemn feast days)

TIP: Instead of abstaining, you may substitute special acts of charity or piety on Fridays

ALL ABOUT Fasting & Abstinence

Why fast?
It helps us to **pray better**: an empty stomach can lead to more attentive prayer

Who has to fast?
Catholics aged 18 to 60
Those with impaired health should not fast in any way.

Why abstain on Fridays?
It’s the **day of Christ’s saving death** on the cross; we abstain to share in His work of saving the world

Who has to abstain?
Catholics aged 14 and older

During Lent, the money we save on food while fasting and abstaining should be given to others in alms

AN ACT OF SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

When circumstances prevent us from attending Mass and receiving Holy Communion, we are invited to receive Communion Spiritually:

“My Jesus, I believe that You are in the Blessed Sacrament.

I love You above all things,

and I long for You in my soul.

Since I cannot now receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart.

As though You have already come,

I embrace You and unite myself entirely to You.

Never permit me to be separated from You.

Amen.”

Recalling St. Juan Diego, to whom Christ’s mother appeared under the name of Our Lady of Guadalupe in present-day Mexico in 1531, Cardinal Burke invited Catholics to ask for the intercession of Our Lady of Guadalupe for *‘maternal care and protection.’*

Recently, he invited Catholics to join in praying a nine-month novena seeking Mary’s intercession beginning on March 12, 2024 and culminating on the feast day of Our Lady of Guadalupe on December 12, 2024. The American cardinal, who founded the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Wisconsin, recently announced the prayer initiative.

“Our Lord has not called us to fear.

No matter the darkness of our age, men and women of faith are not without the truth and love of Christ, nor the faithful care of his mother,” Cardinal Burke wrote in an accompanying letter posed to the Guadalupe shrine website.

“The darkness of sin seems so great. But Our Lord has not called us to fear! Evil cannot approach the power of God’s grace. Sin cannot prevent Our Lord’s healing mercy from reaching those who repent and seek it. And nothing can diminish the care and protection of Our Lady for us, which remain as strong today as they were 500 years ago.”
