V+J March 24, 2024 Salesian Reflection Palm Sunday

In today's readings we experience Jesus as the suffering servant who brings God's love to the human family. St. Francis de Sales reminds us that we are called to be like Jesus:

The most powerful reason for Jesus' death is to fill the human spirit with God's love. Out of death has come life, the wondrous paradox, which the world does not understand. Jesus not only died a cruel death to bring God's love to us, but He also suffered fear, terror, abandonment, and inner depression such as never had and never shall have an equal. He did this so that we too may persevere in pursuing divine love.

Jesus' human feelings left His entire heart exposed to sorrow and anguish. For this reason He cries out: "My God, why have you forsaken me?" Mount Calvary is the mount of lovers. All love that does not take its origins from the Savior's passion is foolish and perilous. On Calvary, we can not have life without love. Nor can we have divine love without dying to our false loves. Christian wisdom consists in choosing rightly. Hence we ought to consecrate every moment of our lives to the eternal divine love of Our Savior's death. This means we need to empty ourselves of all other loves that are destroying us so that we may be filled with God's eternal love that gives life!

So when injured by others, look often with your inward eyes on Christ Jesus, crucified, forsaken and overwhelmed, by every kind of anguish. Then think of the many people who are incomparably more afflicted than you are and say: "Are not my hardships roses in comparison with those, who without help, assistance, or relief live a continual death under the burden of afflictions infinitely greater than mine? When all things fail us, when our distress is at its height, say the final words of Jesus on the cross:

"Into Your hands I commend my spirit."

PALM SUNDAY

The final Sunday before Easter, Palm Sunday represents an important day in Christian worship traditions spanning Catholic, Protestant and Orthodox traditions. In the Catholic Church, Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy

Week. It's a unique, beautiful liturgy that sets the stage for the Easter Triduum and traces its inspiration back to the Gospels. Matthew's Gospel tells us the story of Jesus's journey to Jerusalem as Passover approached. On the next day, when the great crowd that had come to the feast heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, they took palm branches and went out to meet Him, and cried out: "Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Blessed is the kingdom of our father David that is to come! Hosanna, in the highest." When the Gospel makes mention of Jesus riding on a colt or ass, it fulfills the prophecy from Zachariah. As Jesus prepared to celebrate Passover, we celebrate Palm Sunday as we prepare for Easter. The USCCB formally refers to Palm Sunday as "Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion" because it's the day we first hear the Passion reading. We will hear it again on Good Friday, but from a different Gospel. At the start of the Palm Sunday liturgy, the first hymn usually proclaims, "Hosanna," (a word of divine praise that we see in Mark's Gospel). The Responsorial Psalm typically comes from Psalm 22 and features the familiar response, "My God, My God, why have You abandoned me?" Offertory hymns and songs during the Eucharist vary greatly from parish to parish. "Were You There" - a song which depicts Jesus' crucifixion - is one you might hear during Communion. "What Wondrous Love Is This" represents another common hymn. A popular Palm Sunday recessional hymn is "Lift High the Cross." Given that Palm Sunday falls within Lent, music will not feature "Alleluia." The Scriptures and songs are just some of the components of the Palm Sunday liturgy that make it unique. Churches distribute palms. The priest calls the parishioners to either the back of the church or the vestibule, where the first Gospel is read. Once read, our youth wave palms and process as the priest continues into the church and the congregation sings. Not your normal Sunday processional! The palms will later form the ashes distributed on Ash Wednesday to begin Lent the following year. It's a beautiful, engaging worship experience that prepares us for the Easter Triduum.
